School Organizational Team Minutes  
Wednesday, Nov. 29, 2017

The Squires Organizational Team meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m. on November 29, 2017. The meeting was held in the C. P. Squires library.

There were no opening questions or public comments.

New Items – the minutes from the last meeting, held on October 11, were read and approved by committee members.

General Discussion:

Mr. Bosacker began the meeting with a bit of good news – Squires students did show some improvement. This will ensure that Squires will not be on the list of schools which could possibly become Charter Schools for next year.

A discussion of school attire for next year occupied the remainder of the time allotted for the meeting. Squires will have to decide whether to continue the current policy of required school uniforms. If the school decides to survey all of the parents, a committee must be formed. The committee would consist of six parents, two students, two staff members and one administrator. If it is the consensus of the committee that the uniform policy should continue, a formal survey of parents must take place. The survey would cost approximately \$2,000. This cost would be covered by the school. The actual survey would come from the CCSD. The questionnaire would be mailed to the parents. They would complete the survey and return it to the school office.

An informal discussion will take place in order to decide if a formal survey is necessary. The parents in attendance voiced their opinion and talked with each other for about 20 minutes. These parents reported that most of them would go along with whatever the decision may be. Three parents said they would prefer no uniforms and three parents said they like the idea of their children wearing uniforms. The discussion was continuing for such a long time that it was decided to table it and continue it at the next meeting.

Announcements:

Parents were reminded that this Friday, Dec. 1, our school will be holding the annual Winter Wonderland Activity Night. Admission is \$1 per person, or one canned item.

There were no further questions or discussions – meeting adjourned at 3:22.
